

What Causes Does STDs Have On People?

- Sexually transmitted infections can be caused by: Bacteria (gonorrhea, syphilis, chlamydia)
- Parasites (trichomonas Viruses (human papillomavirus, genital herpes, HIV) intestinalis.
- Sexual activity plays a role in spreading many other infectious agents, although it's possible to be infected without sexual contact. Examples include the hepatitis A, B and C.

These are the their meaning

- ♦ Human papillomavirus infection ~ An infection that causes warts in various parts of the body, depending on the strain.
- Genital Herpes ~ A common sexually transmitted infection marked by genital pain and sores.
 - ♦ Chlamydia ~ A common sexually transmitted infection that may not cause symptoms.
 - ♦ Gonorrhea ~ A sexually transmitted bacterial infection that, if untreated, may cause infertility.
- ♦ HIV / AIDS ~ HIV causes AIDS and interferes with the body's ability to fight infections.
- ♦ Syphilis ~ A bacterial infection usually spread by sexual contact that starts as a painless sore.

What symptoms comes with STDs.....

- Sores or bumps on the genitals or in the oral or rectal area
- Painful or burning urination
 Discharge from the penis
 - Unusual or odd-smelling vaginal discharge
 - Unusual vaginal bleedingPain during sex
- Sore, swollen lymph nodes, particularly in the groin but sometimes more widespread
- Lower abdominal pain
- Fever & Rash over the trunk, hands or feet
